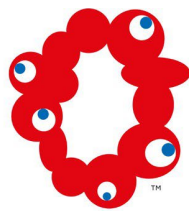

April 2023	Preliminary design submitted to the organisers of Expo 2025 Osaka Kansai and the Osaka Municipality authorities
August 2023	Preliminary design approved
August 2023	Application made for a temporary building permit
September 2023	Temporary building permit approved, with Monaco only the second participant country to receive such approval
September 2023	Final design submitted
November 2023	Final design approved
February 2024	Application made for a final building permit April 2024 Final building permit approved
April 2024	Monaco Pavilion design unveiled
April 2024	Plot officially handed over
May 2024	Pavilion building works begin
January 2025	Installation of scenography and landscaping
13 April 2025	Expo 2025 Osaka Kansai opens
28 June 2025	Monaco National Day
13 October 2025	Expo 2025 Osaka Kansai closes
